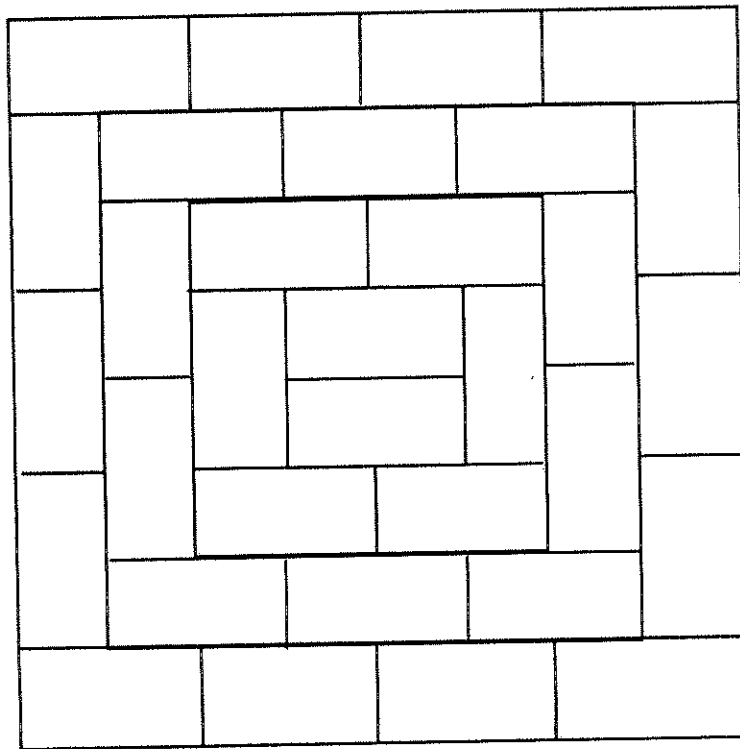


POTATO CHIP BLOCK



For Each Block

Sew 2 rectangles together on the long side.
Sew a rectangle to the top and to the bottom
to create the center of the block.

Press as you go.

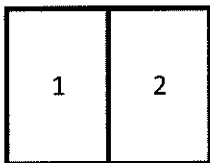
Potato Chip Quilt Block

Each block requires 18 rectangles.

Piece size	Sq Block to	Block Layout	Quilt size
1.5" x 2.5"	6" x 6"	6 across/8 down	Baby Quilt 36" x 48"
2" x 3.5"	9" x 9"	3 across/4 down	
2.5" x 4.5"	12" x 12"	3 across/4 down	Baby Quilt 36" x 48"
3.5" x 6.5"	18" x 18"	4 across/5 down	Twin size 72" x 90"
4.5" x 8.5"			

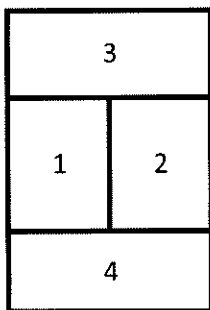
Potato Chip Block assembly

Step 1: Sew two rectangles LONG sides together.



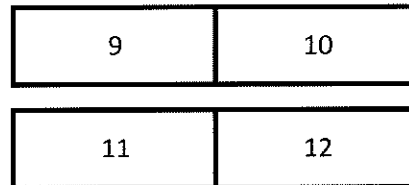
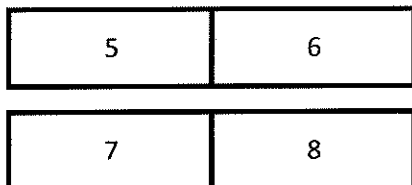
Press seams as you sew.

Step 2: Sew one rectangle on top and one on the bottom.

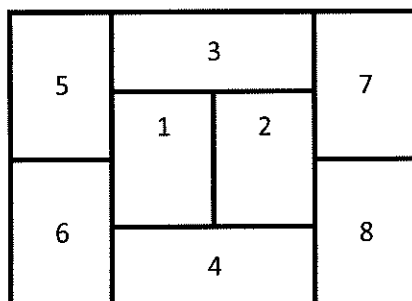


Helpful to lay blocks out on a project board!

Step 3: Sew the SHORT ends of 2 rectangles together. Make 4.

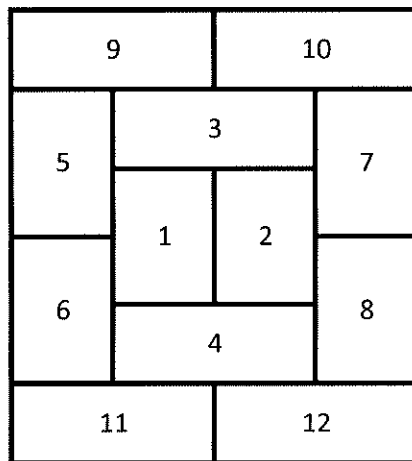


Step 4: Sew two double rectangles (5/6 & 7/8) on either LONG side of the block.

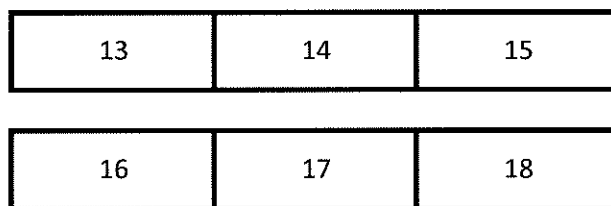


Potato Chip Block assembly

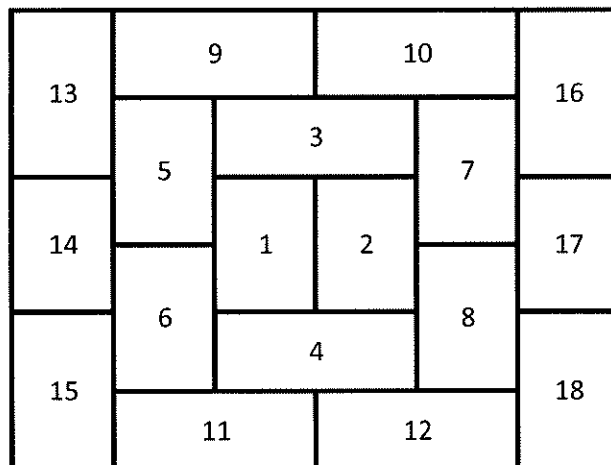
Step 5: Sew the second set (9/10 & 11/12) of double rectangles on top and bottom of block.



Step 6: Sew the SHORT ends of 3 rectangles together. Make 2.



Step 7: Sew these triplicate strips to the long sides of the block.



Square up your blocks!
